What:

- Gender Equity (equivalent to the Commission on the Status and Role of Women, COSROW)
- Gun Violence Prevention
- LGBTQ+ Justice
- Immigration Rights
- Racial Justice
- Restorative Justice
- Wealth and Health Equity

As the playbook is developed (with input from relevant entities), it will be through the teams and working groups this board determines are useful.
