9	All United Methodist Men now come under the General Commission on
10	United Methodist Men as defined by the Book of Discipline for the United
11	Methodist Church.

15	NAME: The name of the organization shall be The United Methodist Men
16	(UMM) of the Baltimore-Washington Conference of the United Methodist
17	Church.

21	PURPOSE: Our purpose is to make and engage men to be disciples of
22	Jesus Christ and enable them to grow spiritually for the transformation of the
23	world.

25	Function: The function of the conference organization of United Methodist
26	Men shall be to work with the district organizations and the local units of
27	United Methodist Men in developing programs to meet the needs and
28	interests of men and the concerns and responsibilities of discipleship; to
29	assist in personal witness and evangelism; to enable outreach in individual
30	and group mission and ministry; to encourage and support spiritual growth
31	and faith development; and to promote the objectives and responsibilities of
32	the General Commission on United Methodist Men.

21	organization does not exist then the Conference United Methodist Men will
22	serve as the District organization.

27	FINANCE:
28	A Finance Committee shall be established by the President, comprised
29	of at least three members: (1) a Finance Committee Chairman selected
30	by the President, (2) Vice President, (3) Treasurer, and (4) any other
31	member(s) of the Baltimore-Washington Conference United
32	Methodist Men that the President deems necessary to carry out the
33	following duties:

	• The program of United Methodist Men shall be financed by such means as the members may approve on the recommendation of the Executive Committee or any other appropriate committee.
	• If the District United Methodist Men cannot meet this criteria then the Conference United Methodist Men will perform the requirement.
	• Fund for support of the Conference United Methodist Men goals, objectives, and program ministries shall be received from:
	 (1) Dues to the budget from local units (2) Voluntary pledges, offerings and gifts. (3) Every Man Shares in Evangelism, Mission, & Spiritual Life
	 A balanced budget shall be presented at the Conference United Methodist Men Annual meeting for approval.
	• All pass due funds shall be disbursed in a timely manner, i.e., funds raised/collected for Food for Millions shall be disbursed to the Society of St. Andrews on a monthly basis.
	• The Finance Committee will conduct an annual audit review of the financial records of the Baltimore-Washington Conference United Methodist Men. This audit will be made available to the Executive Committee no later than three months following the end of the fiscal year. Upon approval by the Executive Committee a copy of the audit shall be provided to the Baltimore-Washington Conference United Methodist Treasurer.
	ARTICLE XI
t	An officer of the Conference, Region, or District United Methodist Men may be charged with the following offenses, and if so may choose a trial in accordance with this article and paragraphs 2702 & 2703 of the 2016 United Methodist Book of Discipline: (a) immorality; (b) crime; (c) disobedience to the order and discipline of The United Methodist Church; (d) dissemination of doctrines contrary to the established standards of doctrine of The United

Methodist Church; (e) sexual abuse; (f) sexual misconduct;* (g) child abuse;

(h) harassment, including, but not limited to racial and/or sexual harassment; 1 (i) racial or gender discrimination; or (j) relationships and/or behaviors that 2 3 (k) Misappropriation of funds or undermine the ministry of persons serving within an appointment. 4 5 The charged officer's Pastor or District Superintendent should take pastoral 6 7 steps to resolve any complaints. If such pastoral response does not result in resolution and a written complaint is made against the officer for any of the 8 offenses in Article XI of these by-laws and ¶ 2702.3 of the Book of 9 Discipline, the Pastor in charge or Co-pastors (¶ 205.1) of his local church, 10 11 in consultation with the District Superintendent and the District or Conference Lay Leader, may appoint a committee on investigation 12 13 consisting of four professing United Methodist Men members and three clergy in full connection (both clergy and professing members must come 14 from other congregations who are charted as United Methodist Men, 15 exclusive of the churches of the respondent or the complainant) Committee 16 members shall be in good standing and should be deemed of good character. 17 18 The committee should reflect racial, ethnic, and gender diversity. In all 19 cases, the Pastor or District Superintendent should take pastoral steps to 20 21 resolve any grievances or complaints. Such steps shall include a just 22 resolution process. If five or more members of the committee so recommend, the charged person shall be suspended from exercising any of 23 his duties as an officer of United Methodist Men pending outcome of the 24 judicial process. The Executive Committee may appoint an interim officer 25 pending the outcome of the judicial process. 26

3. District programs shall incorporate the purpose of United Methodist Men in their planning as stated in the guidelines by the General Commission of the United Methodist Men and by the Baltimore-Washington Conference United Methodist Men.

4. District Presidents shall give a written report of program activity at all Executive Committee Meetings.

5. District Presidents shall emphasize the need for chartering that connects them with the total program of United Methodist Men.

6. District Presidents shall promote Every Man Shares in Evangelism , Mission and Spiritual growth (EMS). EMS is a personal commitment by each member of the United Methodist Men that proclaims his committed life to follow in the footsteps of Jesus in his everyday comings and goings.

7. The President shall appoint special committees as he deems necessary.

8. The President shall appoint a nominating committee for 31 recommending future officers (President, Vice President, 32 33 Secretary, and Treasurer). The committee consists of five persons, 34 representatives of the District Presidents, local church and past Conference Presidents. Members of the nominating committee 35 shall not be nominated for these positions without prior approval of 36 the Executive Committee, and not less than 90 days before the 37 38 scheduled election.

The Conference President nominated must be a member of the United Methodist Church, should have experience as a District President, but if such person is not available the Executive Committee may select a person with sufficient leadership qualifications, and meet other qualifications defined by the Executive Committee.

10. If the Conference President is unable to complete his term of office, the Vice President will serve in the interim until the next quadrennial Annual Meeting.

11. The term of all officers shall follow the General Commission of United Methodist Men quadrennium. The Conference President and Vice President shall not serve more than two (2) consecutive four (4) year terms or as amended by the Executive Committee.

12. If the Vice President, Secretary, or Treasurer is unable to complete a term of office, the Executive Committee can elect a replacement to be approved at the next Annual Meeting.

13. The Constitution and By-Laws may be amended at any Annual or special meeting of the organization by a two-thirds majority vote of all members present, provided the notice of such proposed amendment is given 30 days in advance.

 14. Scheduled Annual Meetings will not be cancelled to suffice other efforts. When necessary other efforts may be included, but not as to interfere with the business of the Annual Meeting. All levels must work hand in hand with each other to reduce conflicting dates.

The integrity of this Conference of United Methodist Men will be maintained as followers of Jesus Christ in all that we do by our study, leadership example, gifts and prayer.
