VISION

Raising one hundred leaders in unceasing and joint prayer for the revival of our hearts, families, churches, communities, and ministries through revival of the United Methodist Men’s Ministry.

STRATEGY

- Daily and weekly prayer sessions led by Prayer Advocates and Leaders.
- Unceasing prayer for revival, renewal, and refreshing. A revival for wholeness that brings forth God’s manifest presence.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. Prayer teams meet weekly to pray for revival. With the guidance, participation, and support of the NACP Leadership and the GCUMM.
2. 30-minute prayer sessions with the following basic agenda:
 - a. 3-5 minutes of Scripture supporting revival.
 - b. 10-12 minutes of prayer for revival of our hearts, families, churches, communities, and the United Methodist Church; through revival of men’s ministry. Prayers for the revival of the GCUMM and NACP.
 - c. Pray for the UMM Vision, Mission, and Values.

- d. 10-15 minutes for prayer concerns from the team.
 - e. Many sessions scheduled weekly throughout the day to offer all an opportunity to join.
3. Commitment to unceasing prayer for this revival. Prayer for God to show His Manifest presence in our lives, churches, and ministry.

COSTS/REVENUE

1. Cost of ZOOM meetings to be borne by team leaders.
2. No expectation of revenue

PRAYER BULLETIN

"If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land." –2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)

In the Scripture above, God urges humility, seeking His face, and turning from wicked ways to heal a nation. It's a timeless call for introspection and repentance, resonating with the essence of spiritual renewal and societal transformation. SCRIPTURAL REFERENCES

Suggestions on using the Scriptural references: Before praying through the following prayer points. Take a Scripture from above as the Spirit leads, read and ask these reflective questions: 1. What is the text saying about the condition of God's people? 2. What is God inviting us to do in the text? 3. What prayer can we pray from the text?

PRAYER POINTS

1. Heavenly Father, we ask that You stretch out Your hands upon us as Your servants and leaders in our homes, businesses, churches, and communities and let there be a mighty move of God in our hearts that will ignite us with hunger, thirst for a deeper relationship with You.
2. Heavenly Father, we ask that You fill our hearts with deep passion for the mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of our homes, families, churches, and communities.
3. Heavenly Father, we pray that You renew our hearts with a fresh knowledge of our callings as fathers and servant leaders in our homes, families, churches, businesses, and communities.
4. Heavenly Father, we raise our voice unto You, and we ask that You visit our homes, families, churches, and communities with the truth of Your saving love in Christ.
5. Heavenly Father, we ask that You make of us, a committed people who will rise to the mission of reaching out to those who are yet to know You, in our families, churches, circle of influence, and communities.
6. Heavenly Father, we want to experience Your presence and power in deeper ways that make us more faithful men, husbands, father-figures, and servant leaders in our families, churches, communities.
7. Heavenly Father, we confess that in and by ourselves, we can do nothing, so we ask that You send the empowerment of Your Spirit upon us, both great and small and give us sufficient capacity to do Your will.
8. Heavenly Father, increase in each of us, a deeper hunger and thirst for the things of the Spirit so we can increase in our knowledge of You and our commitment to serve You more faithfully.
9. Heavenly Father, we ask that You send the flames of Your Spirit upon our souls that will show us and empower us to meet the spiritual needs of the next generation of men in our families, churches, circle of influence, and communities.
10. Heavenly Father, we ask for a new season to break open upon the NACP, GCUMM, and all the UMM in our local churches, a season where our hearts are ignited with the embers of Your Holy Spirit that will make us agents of revival that will extend the frontiers of Your Kingdom across the United States and beyond.
11. Heavenly Father, we ask that You send Your Spirit upon us and equip us with the spiritual gifts so we can walk in the riches of Your power individually and corporately.
