- **2018 Year End Report**

Richard handed out a copy of the report that was presented to the BWC UMM Executive Board on Jan 12, 2019. The report was accepted with minor corrections.
- **Welcome New Prayer Advocate**

Morgan welcomed Robert Smith as our new District UMM Prayer Advocate. Robert is a member of the Mt. Zion UMC of Magothy and an active member of its UMM unit.
- **Vacant Officer Positions**

Morgan reminded the Board that we need to continue recruiting for the vacant positions

- **New Business**
 - **Feb 2 Potato Drop at Glen Burnie UMC**

Richard reported that the potato project previously scheduled for Sept 15, 2018 is confirmed to its new date, Feb 2, 2019, 7:00 am. The event will be held at Glen Burnie UMC, 5 Second Ave., SE, Glen Burnie, MD. This is a rain or shine event. The plan includes preparing 1,000 10-lb bags for distribution by the volunteers to the communities of Meade Heights and Pioneer City. Richard presented a proof of the “God Loves You” card to be included in the 10-lb bags of potatoes. **The board approved giving \$25 toward the estimated \$75 for printing 500 cards.**

○ **Reaching Churches to Charter in 2019**

Morgan Smith reported the chartered UMM units in the district are decreasing. We need to make this a priority for 2019 to change this trend by emphasizing how being chartered is 1) required by the Book of Discipline, and 2) being chartered ensures continuous support by the district, conference and general commission of UMMen. **Richard will prepare a list of all churches chartered to date, with the contact information of the President and for all churches chartered and not chartered will include contact information for the Pastor.** The list will be grouped by clusters: North, South, East, West & Central. At our next meeting we will assign persons to each cluster.

○ **Prison Ministry – Alternative to Violence (AVP)**

Richard presented a new ministry on behalf of Andre Myers of St Mark UMM, Hanover. The Alternatives to Violence Project (AVP) is a volunteer-run conflict transformation program. Teams of trained AVP facilitators conduct experiential workshops to develop participants' abilities to resolve conflicts without resorting to manipulation, coercion, or violence. Richard presented a list of the upcoming workshops and suggested the best way to become informed to determine if this is a ministry God is call you to is to attend the Basic workshop. **A motion was made to recommend to Malcolm Clory, organizer for the upcoming prayer breakfast, that 5 to 10 minutes be given to a presenter from AVP.**



- **Other: UMM Flash Mob Ministry:**

Robert suggested that we need to get men from all churches in the District to attend another church in unison on a monthly or every 5th Sunday to experience the cultural differences of their brothers in Christ. This would build relationships through a worship experience. For example, if each church could get 12 men each to volunteer for a month, we would have at least 63 men gather. A motion was made and seconded to have the first UMM Flash Mob at Glen Burnie UMC. **Richard will prepare a calling list for each church and at the next meeting the Board we would allocate the calling list and develop the script.**

- **Prayer Requests and Closing Prayer: Robert Smith**

Prayers were asked for Marvin Hall, who is recuperating from heart surgery; Gloria Smith, Shelby Hemphill's wife, Mark Campbell, Richard's brother who is going through Radiation and Chemotherapy for Cancer diagnosed on Dec 2018; Lillian Hebron, Darwin's mom; Morgan's brother Jeffery; and Rev. Ed Ankeny's wife who died.

Special Annapolis District Board Meeting via Text/Phone/Email

At the request of Morgan Smith, District President, two budget issues arose after its last Executive Board Meeting.

1. \$75 Postcard printing and mailing

- a. Morgan, is asking approval from the District Board to approve sending postcards to every church in our district to Pastor, UMM President or Treasurer and EMS/Legacy UMM to promote the March 16 BWC UMM Annual Prayer Breakfast at Calvary UMC, Annapolis. The estimated cost is \$75.00. .
- b. On Feb 5, 2019 9 votes were received from 70% of the Board in the affirmative, yes with 0 votes in the no.

2. \$200 donation to the Baltimore-Washington Conference United Methodist Men

- a. Hampton Conway. Jr, BWC UMM requested via email on Feb 6, 2019, a \$200 donation to the BWC UMM. This is a line item in the approved 2019 BWC UMM budget by those in attendance at the BWC UMM Annual Meeting on Oct 20, 2018. Hampton said the \$200 donation is for the GCUMM Prayer Center.
- b. Richard on behalf of Morgan all members of the Executive Board were contacted on Feb 6, 2019 by text, email or phone for a vote to approve.
- c. On Feb 7, 2019, 7 votes were received from 60% of the board, all in the affirmative.
- d. Richard will prepare a check request form for Ken to send a \$200 check to Sherman Harris.

2018 Accomplishments:

- Completed a PowerPoint Presentation to give at local churches about the Annapolis District UMM.
- Started the planning of an online study, titled, ENOUGH: The Generous Disciple, which will be lead by two of District Past Presidents. Plans are to launch in 2019.
- Continued recruiting volunteers for our *Geeks for Jesus* ministry, which will provide free technical assistance regarding church web, emails, Facebook, computers, hosting servers, and networking. We are working with Geeks for God, a non-denominational organization for help in recruiting volunteers. We hope to have this ministry operational in 2019.
- Held an End Hunger Project in Annapolis & Cheltham Food Bank, MD in Feb 2018 feeding 5,000 families.
- Greg Witte, Immediate Past District UMM President, graciously awarded \$2,500 from his place of work to the BWC UMM (\$1,000), Annapolis District (\$1,000) and Rev. Dr. Rebecca Iannicelli with the Suzanne Wesley Award (\$500). Greg was recognized for his generosity at our Annual District Meeting.
- Held our 1st District UMM Family Day at Quiet Waters Park, MD where 80 men, women and children attended and were served fried fish, crab cakes and chicken along with an assortment of side dishes and desserts.
- Glen Burnie UMC, an Annapolis District Church hosted on November 10, 2018, the Conference presentation of Rev. Rick Vance, Director of Men's Ministry for the GCUM. Thirty-three UMM attended.
- Held our Annual District United Methodist Men Meeting at Asbury Town Neck UMC on December 8, 2018 with special guest speaker, Derek G. Charter & EMS Report: 25 Churches are Chartered through 2018 or 2019. Two churches, St Mark UMM, Hanover and Hope Memorial St. Mark, did not renew their charters in 2018 or 2019. **Table 1** is a list of all churches in our district and the status of their charter. Our goal for 2019 is to contact the churches who are not chartered and show them the benefits of being chartered and being EMS members. We have developed a PowerPoint presentation and finalizing a trifold brochure to share with them.
