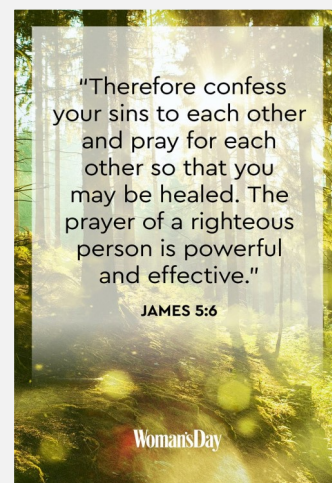
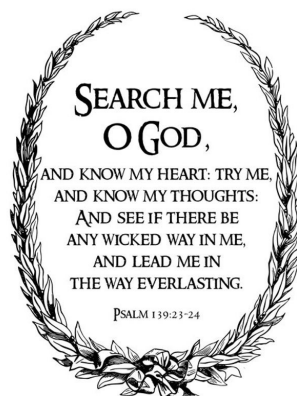

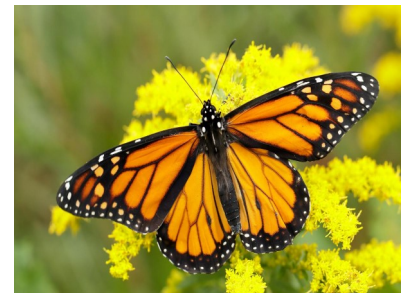

From Caterpillar to Butterfly

The butterfly and the caterpillar develop through a process called metamorphosis. This is a Greek word that means transformation or change in shape. The caterpillar grows through stages to be a butterfly. When you first look at them they are not very attractive. But in time as they grow they will eventually transform into a beautiful creature the butterfly. The colors of a butterfly is amazing. There are about 17,500 species of butterflies in the world and around 750 species in the United States. Butterflies are the only group of insects that have scales covering their wings, although some butterflies have reduced scales. The most beautiful butterfly is the Blue Morpho calling Central and South America it's home. The blue morpho is one the world's largest butterflies.

The Christian's Transformation from sinner to Christ like is very similar. 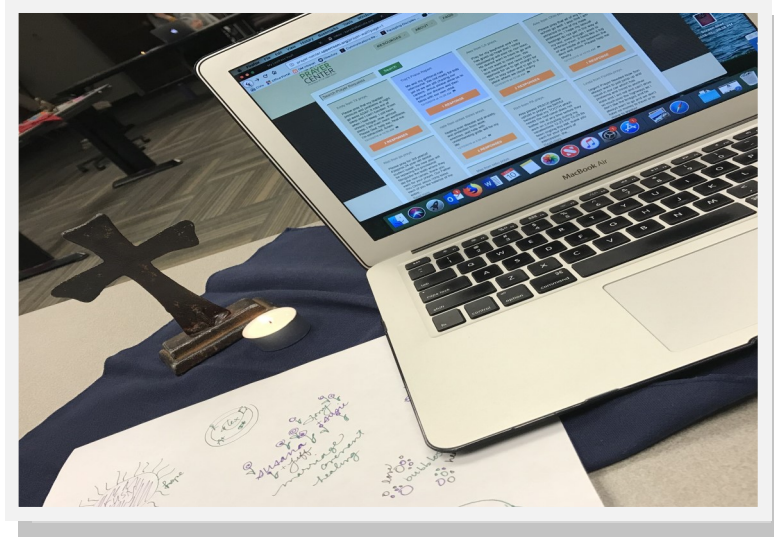
- (1) Recognize God's voice—Discover God's plan for our lives
